Additionally, students are prepared for the reception of the sacraments including First Reconciliation, First Communion, and Confirmation.

# Faith in Action

Sacred Heart students are encouraged to not only learn, but live the Faith. They are taught to live beyond themselves sharing their time, talent, and treasures. Through works of corporal mercy including mission collections, community outreach, and service projects—our students grow into compassionate leaders and faithful disciples. Students participate in Mass regularly as altar servers, cantors, and readers. Students also have the opportunity to attend school-sponsored mission and vocation trips throughout the year.



Additionally, high school students are required to complete 25 hours of Christian Ministry service hours each school year. At Sacred Heart, we believe that Christian Ministry is an important component of religious instruction in that it provides experiences for students to grow in their faith and participate in serving our brothers and sisters in Christ. Service opportunities include volunteering at meaningful outreach programs, assisting with Vacation Bible School, participating in mission trips, and so much more.
