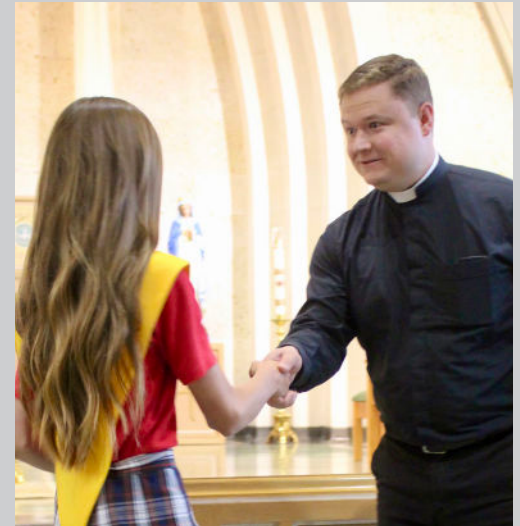

Sacred Heart is the only school in the Diocese of Fort Worth offering PreK3 through 12th Grade education. With affordable tuition and discounts available, families can fulfill the dream of sending their children to a distinguished, parochial Catholic school. From Montessori onward, the curriculum at Sacred Heart is carefully designed to encompass core academic subjects alongside religious and classical education. Our small class sizes, averaging 10-20 students, create a supportive and collaborative learning environment. High school students can take advantage of our NCTC Dual Credit program, earning over 50 hours of college credit while completing high school work. Additionally, Sacred Heart is committed to helping students with special learning needs with a dedicated special resources instructor and dyslexia specialist.
