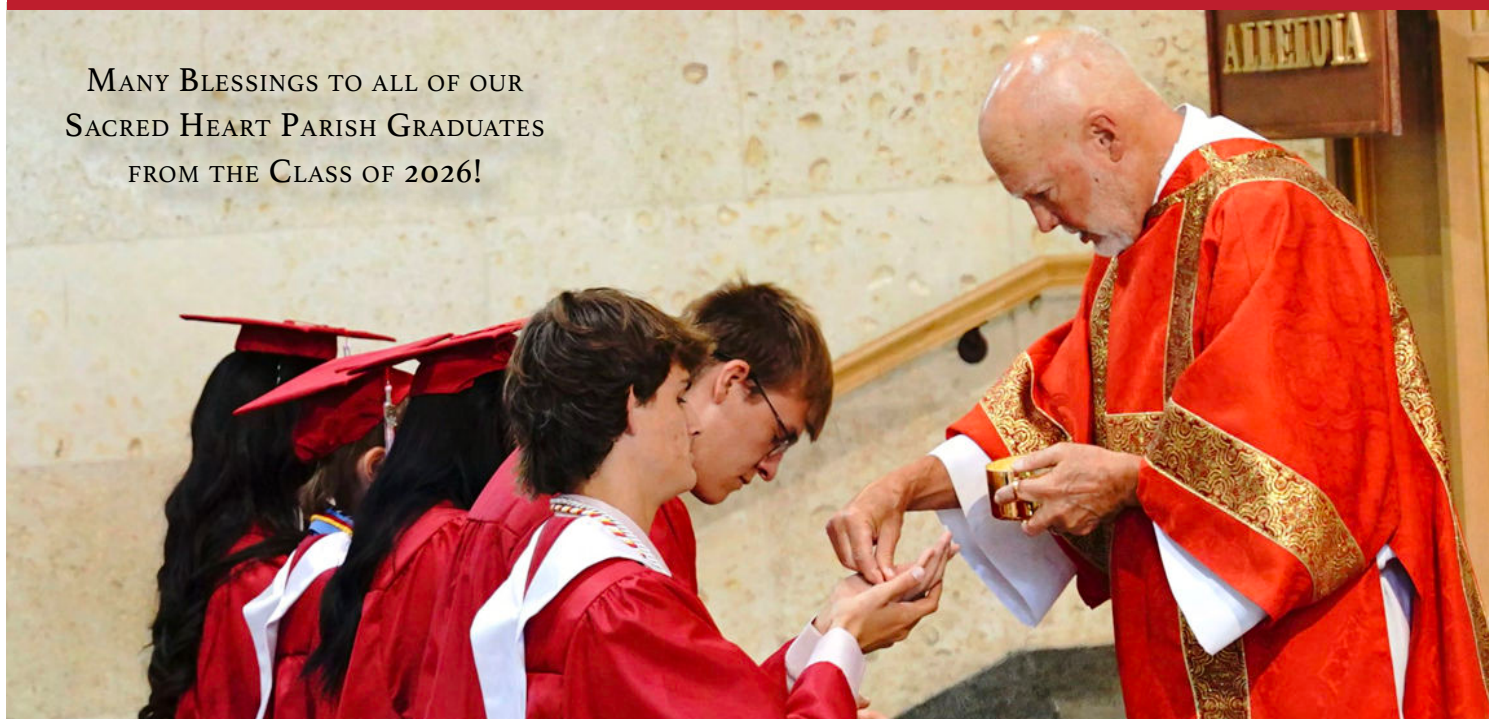

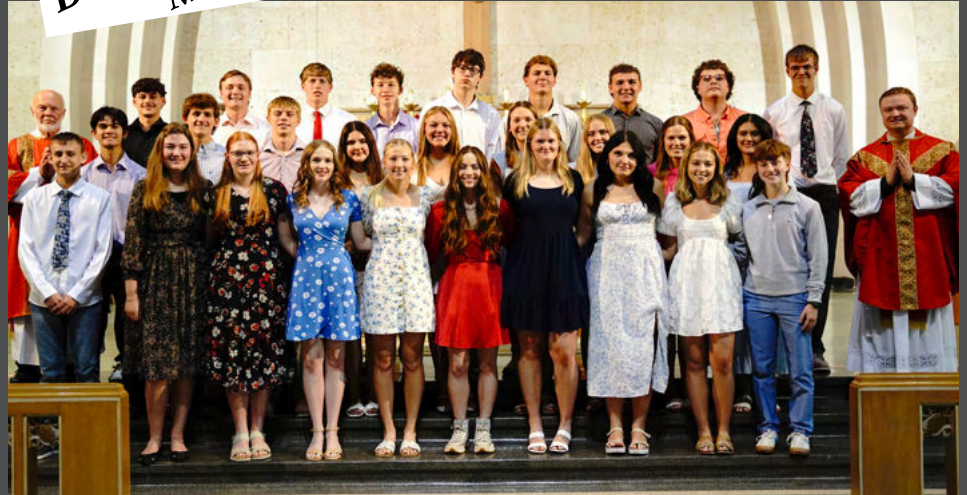
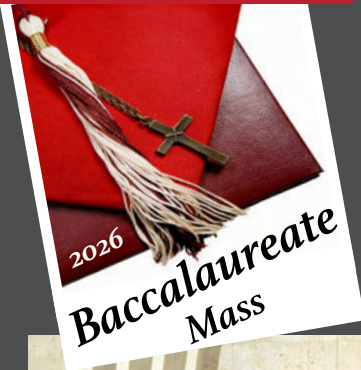

Faith, Fellowship & Fun at SH Youth Group!



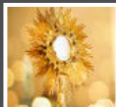
End-of-School-Year Youth Group Celebration!

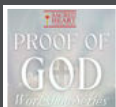

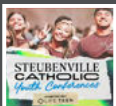

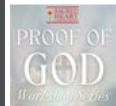
